


KNOCK, KNOCK

The Strickland House, Raleigh

> The entrance to the 1800-squarefoot house is a progression from the top of the hill, across a bridge, and into the balcony/foyer, at which point the drama of the scenery outside immediately fills the interior through two-story, floor-to-ceiling, north-facing glass walls. The master bedroom suite is located on the balcony level, where Strickland used sheets of scrap metal to clad low partitions around the master bath.

> From the balcony, a graceful sal-vaged-steel staircase with wooden treads descends past the glass (in essence, through the trees) to the dramatic, two-story-clear main living floor, which, in turn, opens onto a sunny and partially secluded southfacing terrace below the bridge. The main floor includes the living/dining/ kitchen space (open to each other), another full bathroom, and an additional room that the owner uses as a media room and guest bedroom when necessary

At all times of the day, the house is filled with a view of nature and, by day, dappled light. Deep roof overhangs shade the glass and extend a visual link to the outdoors. Laminated wood columns and beams, plainly bracketed, strengthen the presence of nature and echo the trees beyond. The roof beams reach out to the sky like tree limbs.




